Asian Studies Center Professional Development grants, 2023-2024

Dear Asian Studies colleagues,

The Asian Studies Center at GSU supports individual and collaborative research on Asia-related topics by GSU faculty and graduate students. The center offers small professional development (seed) grants (up to \$800 for faculty and \$350 for graduate students) to visit libraries/archives, present research papers at conferences/workshops, visit/invite research collaborators, purchase research materials (books, reproduction of sources, copyrights, etc.), or cover other research and publication costs (professional editing, translation, etc.). Grant recipients are expected to participate in the center's activities and present their research at the fall or spring colloquium. It is also expected that they acknowledge the center when the research is published.

Please send your proposal (in no more than 3 pages) with a description of the project (intended research) and a budget statement and justification. The deadline to submit a funding request is **Monday, October 16, 2023**. Email your application to asc@gsu.edu. The Executive Committee will evaluate the proposals and recommend funding soon after the October 16 deadline. **All grant money must be used before the end of June 2024.**
